"I am Here, I Belong" Photo Exhibition, 18-30 Dec

#IBelong Event

Every ten minutes, one stateless child is born somewhere in the world. In West Malaysia, DHRRRA has registered approximately 12,000 stateless people who are yet to confirm and acquire their nationality. In conjunction with the first year Anniversary of Global #IBelong Campaign to End Statelessness in 10 years, or by 2024, a public event was held to highlight the issues and concerns of stateless communities globally and in Malaysia.

The exhibition featured photos of stateless young people, taken by photographers Roger Arnold and Ted Adnan, and stateless youths themselves. As part of our efforts to give a voice to this invisible struggle, we asked some of the youths we have assisted through our paralegal assistance project to photograph the world around them, as they see it. A selection of these photos were also exhibited during the event depicting their surroundings, and the people and things most important to them.



Teacher's Guide to Teaching on Statelessness
